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The ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview, or OPI, is a valid and reliable testing method that measures how well a person speaks a language. It is a standardized procedure for the global assessment of functional speaking ability, i.e., it measures language production holistically by determining patterns of strengths and weaknesses.

An Italian language specific 4-day OPI training (novice, intermediate, advanced and superior levels) is offered at The American University of Rome.
