The University has a limited number of scholarships, which include student training positions and AUR scholarships. Funds awarded are applied to tuition expenses. If tuition is already paid in full, student may choose to be reimbursed for the number of hours worked. The value of AUR scholarships will not exceed the cost of tuition. The student training program is only renewable by semester depending on the signature and approval of the tutor of the department. Students must also maintain full time status and remain in good academic standing (2.7 cumulative GPA or above) to be eligible.

Only returning AUR students and incoming transfer students are eligible to apply for the student training program.

An email will be sent to eligible applicants with a list of student training positions when they become available for the upcoming semester. Further instructions about the application process will be included in the email sent to applicants by financial aid.
